

## 2009 LEAF WASTE COLLECTION SCHEDULE

North Whitehall Township Department of Public Works will begin its 2009 Leaf Waste Collection Program. **Starting Monday, May 4, 2009 through Friday, May 8, 2009.** Leaf waste is defined as leaves, garden residues, shrubbery trimmings, tree twigs, and similar material, **but no grass clippings.** The Township will have one crew covering the entire Township per the following schedule:

Monday	Orefield Area Addresses
Tuesday	Schnecksville
Wednesday	Neffs Area Addresses
Thursday	Laurys Station and Slatington, North Whitehall Area Addresses
Friday	Coplay and Allentown, North Whitehall Area Addresses

- All residents in the Township should place their leaf waste **along the edge of the road**, prior to the start of pickup at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, May 4.
- Please do not place any type of heavy object (pieces of wood, steel, rocks, or concrete) on top of your piles to weigh them down. These objects will cause extensive damage to our collection equipment, which in turn will stop the process and cost extra taxpayer dollars.
- If you can, rake all your yard waste into a long row in the gutter area, but **nothing in plastic bags or other containers.**
- Crews **will not collect yard waste on your property, nor will they empty bags or containers;** this is the responsibility of the resident.
- To facilitate the collection, **please keep all vehicles away from the area where the yard waste is piled.** The crews will not rake piles out from or under the car or between any parked cars.
