

End Product: The yard waste, grass and leaves are transported to the Middle Smithfield Materials, Inc. and are processed into mulch and compost, which are made available at a cost. Contact Middle Smithfield Materials, Inc at 610-799-4177 for additional information.

Warning: There have been a few incidents of dumping of non-recyclable materials in the yard waste recycling bins. If this abuse continues to occur, it may be necessary to limit access to the recycling area. The recycling bays are **for the convenience of Township Residents** and are only for designated items.

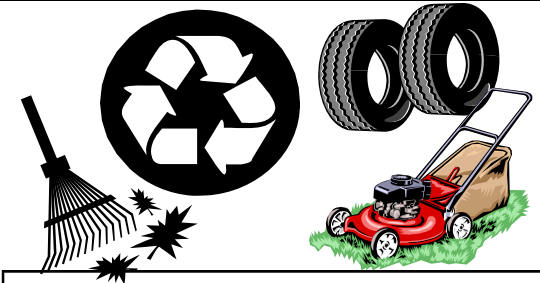

Household Hazardous Waste: Previously, the Lehigh County Office of Solid Waste Management held waste collection programs. On designated days residents could take items such as paints, fertilizers, fluorescent light tubes, alkaline batteries, etc. Due to budget cuts and other factors this program has been placed on hold. If you have an excess of material that is still usable it is recommended that you try to see if a neighbor or friend might get use out of it before trying to dispose of it. If you find that some items are just not of use any longer, you may contact Tim Bollinger at the Lehigh County Government Center for more options. Large Item Recycling: The Township Office receives numerous calls requesting information regarding disposal of large articles. The Lehigh Valley Recycling Center, 3947 Portland Street, Ormrod, accepts large recyclable items such as furniture, appliances, and cardboard (a fee is charged). The charge and list of items is subject to change, so we suggest residents contact the center before making a drop-off, 610-261-9139, or check with your individual trash hauler.

Township Municipal Building.**






