**Ordinance 2021-2**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH WHITEHALL, LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE 2008-2 AND ORDINANCE 2018-1 REGARDING OPEN BURNING AND THE ADDITION OF PROCEDURES FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A FIRE WARNING OR BAN**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of North Whitehall Township, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, is desirous of amending the provisions of Ordinance 2008-02 and Ordinance 2018-1 regarding open burning; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of North Whitehall Township is authorized by the Second-Class Township Code, the Act of May 1, 1933 (P.L. 103, No. 69), as amended, to establish such rules and regulations and has previously done so by adopting Ordinance 2008-02 and Ordinance 2018-1.

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of North Whitehall Township, a municipal corporation and Township of the Second Class, duly organized and lawfully existing in the County of Lehigh, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

- I. AMENDMENT: Ordinance 2018-1 is hereby amended by revising item 6.3.a. with the following:
  6. A fire set solely for cooking food, recreational or ceremonial purposes.
3. Shall not be located:
  - a. within twenty (20) feet of a structure, vehicle or combustible materials.

AMENDMENT: Ordinance 2008-2 is hereby amended to add the following:

Section VI (6) The Township Fire Marshall shall declare a fire warning or burning ban for North Whitehall Township when he or she deems the conditions are appropriate and inform the Township Manager of said decision so that it may be circulated and communicated throughout the Township.


- II. BALANCE OF ORDINANCE 2008-02. The balance of Ordinance 2008-02 remains in full force and effect.
- III. REPEALER. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith in whole or in part are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such conflict.


- IV. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after the enactment thereof.
- V. CERTIFICATION. The Township Secretary to the Board of Supervisors of North Whitehall Township shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance, after the public hearing thereon, and this meeting of the Board being a duly authorized and advertised public meeting, and shall cause the same to be filed as required by law.




