- Township Building Renovation Report provided under "Presentation" section of agenda by John Carson of the Pelorus Group.
- IRT Pedestrian Rapid Flashing Lights The Public Works Team has installed the signalized cross walk at Mauch Chunk Road and has placed temporary crosswalk markings. ADA pads and thermoplast crosswalks will be completed in the Spring.
- Open Space Action Plan Key person interviews will take place on Thursday, January 16. After the interviews are completed, staff will meet with Gilmore and Associates to discuss next steps.
- Farmland Preservation The annual holiday letter was mailed out to landowners in the Township
 who own 10 or more acres. This letter highlighted our recent program success and offered an
 opportunity to connect with staff to discuss farmland and open space preservation options. The
 Wagner family sign was installed on Fairview Road this week to discuss the proper placement of
 the preservation sign for their property.
- Flock License Plate Readers w/ PSP: The Township Manager has been working with Lt.
 Troutman from the Pennsylvania State Police to identify key areas in the township for LPRs. The current system being utilized by PSP is through FLOCK and they have been successfully apprehending wanted persons through the use of LPR cameras. Unfortunately, PSP will not pay for these, and it would be up to the Township to purchase them. However, other surrounding municipalities have successfully worked with their commercial partners to offset the costs.

MANAGERS REPORT CONT'D

- Horseshoe Road Our Public Works Director followed up with Earth Engineering this morning regarding the preliminary geotechnical analysis for the stability of the road and how bad the slop failure really is. We anticipate having the results back from EE within the next two weeks. That date will then be analyzed and used to work with our engineers on the most cost effective approach for the Township
 - Bryan Horwith, , Coplay, asked if the Flock License Plate Reader would be a single unit that is mobile.
